

**Coaches:**

**Please note the following specifics related to meet age divisions and competition levels.**

**Boys**

Due to small number the following will occur;

Level 7's will compete as level 8-9

Level 8-9 will compete as one group with one age group total number - 9

No team competition will be held for level 8-9 boys due to low number

**All American status will be awarded to the top three boys in level 8-9 (Jackets and trophies)**

**Top two level 8-9 boys on 4 events will perform routines at finals for exhibition only**

Boys level 4 will receive medals (not achievement awards)

Boys level 4, 5 (two separate levels) will be awarded by two age groups each - Jr.- Sr. and be split in half to determine age groups total number - 4's-17, 5's - 15

Boys level 6 will compete as one age group - total number 9

**Girls Prep-Optional**

**All Prep- Optional will be judged as Silver Level**

Two age groups - Jr. Sr. - total number divided into two to determine age groups - total number 49

**Girls level 2-3**

2's will be combined with level 3's and split into two age groups - Jr. Sr. and total number divided into two to determine age groups. Total number - 41

The remainder of the levels will be per Y National rules.
